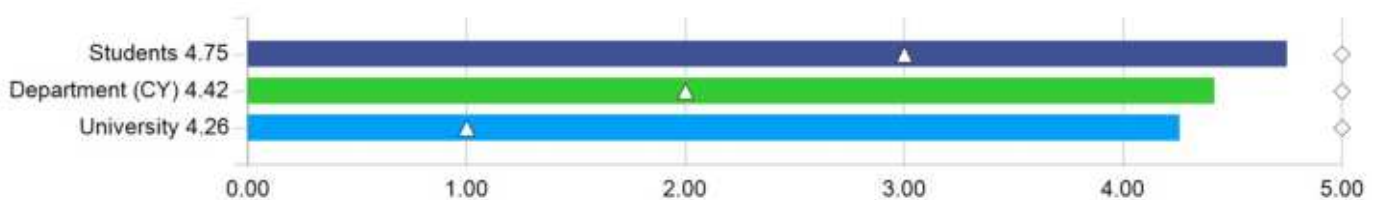

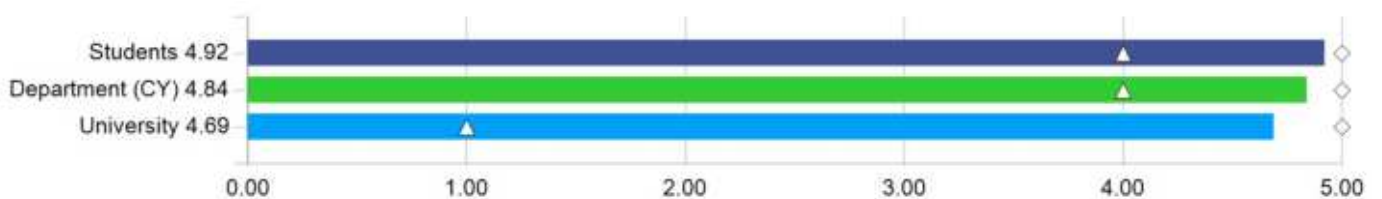

One of the main strengths of this course was its practical, hands-on approach. The instructor was knowledgeable and explained complex topics—like buffer overflows, injection attacks, and secure coding practices—in a clear and structured way. I think Kaan does a great job providing the necessary tools for you to figure out problems on your own in assignments. Assignments involve creative thinking while not feeling too obtuse or confusing.
Kaan has in depth knowledge of the subject he taught. He pushes you to think and solved critical problems. This course was really helpful to assess myself based on my knowledge to my field. A lot of hands on experience, which probably I haven't seen in most of the classes here.

I really like how the course was set up and run and can't think of any improvements.
The course was already intense and well-designed, so I wouldn't suggest adding more content. However, the instructor could consider slightly slowing down during complex topics and providing more simplified explanations or quick recaps to help students keep up more easily.
Challenge 7 was disproportionately difficult compared to the rest of the challenges, while challenge 5 and 6 were the opposite. I think it would have been better if the challenge 5 and 6 were combined, challenge 6 became about just ASLR, and challenge 7 was combining everything with the canary + ret2lib. Having to research and implement the canary, ASLR, and ret2libc all at once was pretty difficult.
I wish he provided one hint each for all the bonuses on the last day of submissions.

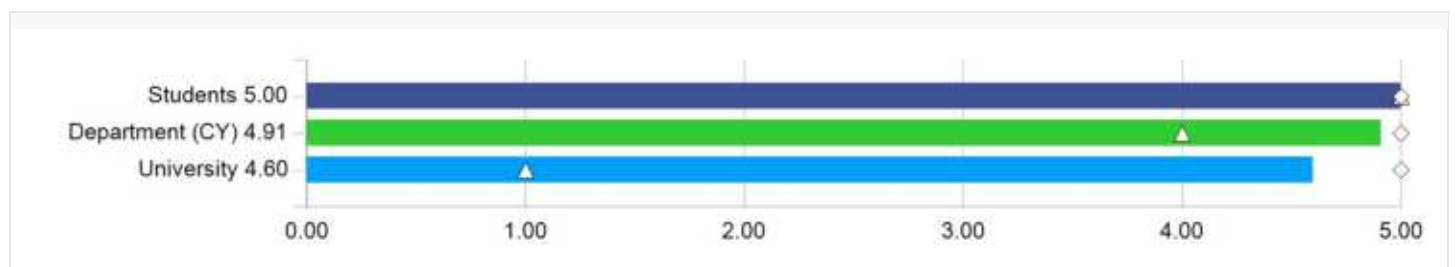

The instructor did a really good job of balancing concepts learned in class and application in the homework and even set class time up to facilitate this. Having the opportunity and dedicated time to ask questions in person at the end of every class really helped.
One of the instructor's key strengths in facilitating inclusive learning is the use of hands-on challenges that are directly relevant to real-world applications. These practical tasks not only reflect current industry scenarios but also accommodate diverse learning styles by encouraging active, experiential learning. The instructor also ensures that ample time is provided for each challenge, allowing students with varying levels of background knowledge and pace to fully engage with the material, apply their skills, and build confidence in a supportive environment.
The instructor did an excellent job facilitating inclusive learning. They were approachable, respectful, and made sure everyone felt comfortable asking questions and participating. There's nothing I would suggest improving in this aspect.
For accessibility, it would be nice if we had the auto transcription for recorded lectures. Sometimes I remember something important you said during one of the lectures and want to find it, and end up scrubbing through the recordings for half an hour. I can however understand why you wouldn't want to turn this feature on.
Professor Kaan didn't just teach the course, he fundamentally changed the way we think. His approach encourages deep reflection and critical analysis rather than rote learning. The assignments and challenges he designed were some of the most engaging I've encountered; they pushed us to apply concepts creatively and think beyond the classroom, making the learning experience both inclusive and intellectually stimulating

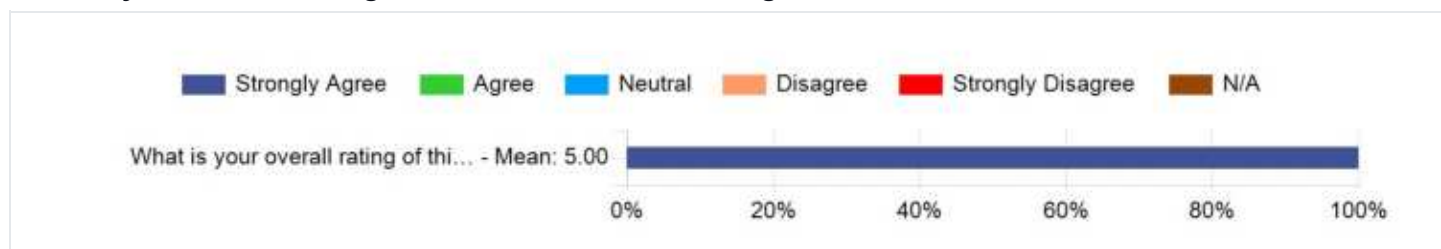


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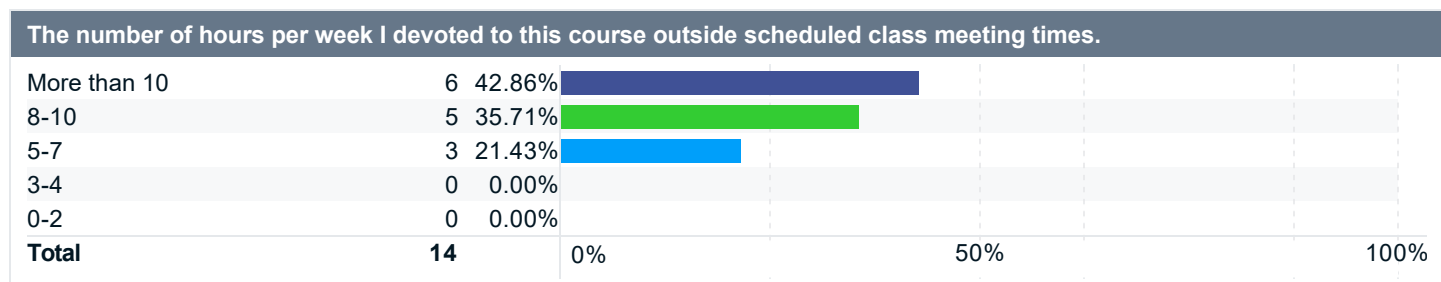
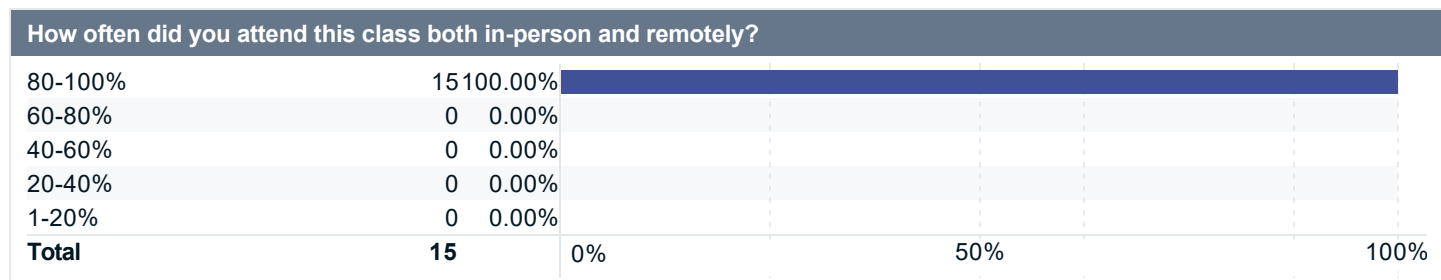

To make the most of this course, I could have spent more time practicing hands-on challenges outside of class, such as working on Capture the Flag (CTF) problems or exploring real-world vulnerabilities in safe environments. Reviewing lecture materials more consistently and diving deeper into tools like Ghidra, Burp Suite, and Wireshark would have also strengthened my understanding. Participating more actively in discussions and seeking clarification on complex topics sooner would have helped me engage better with the material.
I think I could have utilized Piazza more, rather than saving most of my questions for office hours.
I could have started the challenges early on and focused on completing the bonuses.
